LEVEL 4/5 APPRENTICESHIP IN CHILDRENS CARE, LEARNING, PLAY AND DEVELOPMENT



The apprenticeship is suitable for:

Individuals who work or are looking to work in a role where they lead or manage a childcare setting for children under 8 years old. Locations can include day nurseries, play groups and schools.

The 24/36-month programme contains:

Level 4 (24 months)

- Professional Practice in Children's Care, Play, Learning and Development

Level 5 (36 months)

- Leadership and Management of Children's Care, Play, Learning and Development

Information to remember:

To start an apprenticeship in Wales, you need to:

- be aged 18 or over (no upper age limit)
- live in Wales
- not be in full-time education
- not be in receipt any other Welsh Government funding

If you are looking to undertake an apprenticeship qualification as a way of upskilling in your current role, you will also need to:

- be working for at least 10 hours a week
- have the support of your employer to undertake the qualification
- be working in a qualification-relevant role
- be employed for at least 51% of your contracted hours in Wales
